- 3) BOSA Executives:- What should be the job plan for SAS doctors in orthopaedics.

The second meeting is the 7th BOSA ANNUAL MEETING 2011 - 4th & 5th November at the Postgraduate Centre, Royal National Orthopaedic Hospital, Stanmore, Middlesex.
